

As a result of the electro-plating process, fasteners in property classes >=10.9 (>HRC 31) are susceptible to hydrogen embrittlement.

Limited use:

These screws should not be used for transmitting high axial forces. The hexagon socket is intended only for holding the screw to prevent rotation during tightening of the nut. If they are nevertheless tightened by means of the hexagon socket, the torques must be reduced because the key size is smaller and the depth of the hexagon socket is smaller. Property class 10.9. serves only for reducing the wear of the hexagon socket.
